- how to recognize child sexual and physical abuse, exploitation and domestic violence
- your reporting obligations under the Medical Practice Act and Regulatory Provisions Concerning Public Health

Frequently Asked Questions & Answers

Q: How do I reapply for licensure?

A: You can reapply for licensure through the Division of Professional Regulation's website at https://delpros.delaware.gov/OH HomePage

Q: Do I have to complete the mandatory training before I renew my license?

A: Yes. You must complete the training before every renewal, and you must attest to completing the training on your renewal application.

Failure to do so will delay the renewal of your license.

O: If I recently completed a mandatory reporting training, do I need to take this?

A: **Yes.** You **must** take the 2023 Mandatory Reporting training.

The new training will be available on January 1, 2023.

Q: How do I take the 2023 Mandatory Reporting Training?
