Vaccine Code

CPT^{®a} code 90662 should be assigned on all claims for Fluzone High-Dose vaccine.

CPT Code	Code Description
90662	Influenza virus vaccine, split virus, preservative free, enhanced immunogenicity via increased antigen content, for intramuscular use

In addition to the CPT code, some health plans require the use of an 11-digit National Drug Code (NDC) on all claims for physician-administered products. Influenza vaccines are licensed each year with new NDCs, and the grid below contains the Fluzone High-Dose vaccine NDC with "xx" to identify the numbers that change for each influenza season. Refer to the vaccine packaging for the correct NDC code. Note that Fluzone High-Dose vaccine packaging contains a 10-digit NDC. To convert it to the required 11-digit format, you must add a leading "0" to the middle set of digits. (See the leading "0" identified in blue in the grid below.)

Injectable Immunization Administration Codes

The administration of Fluzone High-Dose vaccine must be reported in addition to the vaccine product code, 90662. Because this product is indicated for individuals 65 years of age and older, the following administration codes apply:

Code Required when Billing Medicare Plans for the Administration of Influenza Vaccine

HCPCS Code	Description
G0008	Administration of Influenza virus vaccine

Medicare **requires** use of Healthcare Common Procedural Coding System (HCPCS) codes for the administration of the vaccines that they cover preventively, including influenza vaccine. HCPCS code G0008 must be used when billing Medicare for the administration of Fluzone vaccine. This includes Fluzone High-Dose vaccine.

Code Accepted when Billing Non-Medicare Plans for the Administration of Influenza Vaccine

CPT Code	Code Description
90471	Immunization administration (includes percutaneous, intradermal, subcutaneous, or intramuscular injections); 1 vaccine (single or combination vaccine/toxoid)
+90472	Immunization administration (includes percutaneous, intradermal, subcutaneous, or intramuscular injections); each additional vaccine, (single or combination vaccine/toxoid)

CPT code 90471 is a primary or "first" immunization administration code. Only one first administration may be reported during a single patient encounter. Each additional immunization administration during this same encounter would be represented by the immunization administration add-on code 90472. Bill the appropriate code for administration of Fluzone High-Dose vaccine based on whether or not it was the first or an additional vaccine administered at that visit.

Diagnosis Codes (ICD-9-CM)

Below are suggested diagnosis codes that may be appropriate when submitting claims for Fluzone High-Dose vaccine and its administration. The code should be linked to both the vaccine and the administration codes. Assign the appropriate code based on review of the documentation in the medical record.

ICD-9-CM Code	Code Description	Suggested Use
V04.81	Need for prophylactic vaccination and inoculation against certain viral diseases, other viral diseases, Influenza	Primary diagnosis code used for influenza vaccine and its administration
V06.6	Need for prophylactic vaccination and inoculation against combination of diseases, streptococcus pneumoniae [pneumococcus] and influenza	Primary diagnosis code used when influenza <i>and</i> pneumococcal vaccines are administered at the same visit

Coding Example #1 – A Medicare patient visits the office only to receive their Fluzone High-Dose vaccine.

Code Fluzone High-Dose vaccine using 90662 and its administration to a Medicare patient using G0008. Link both codes to the appropriate ICD-9 code.

Coding Example #2 – A Medicare patient is seen for an injured knee, and the physician uses this visit as an opportunity to administer Fluzone High-Dose vaccine.

Use modifier -25 to indicate that the services performed (ie, administration of Fluzone High-Dose vaccine) are separate and significant from the reason for the visit.

Code Fluzone High-Dose vaccine using 90662 and its administration to a Medicare patient using G0008. Link both codes to the appropriate ICD-9 code.

Coding Example #3 – A non-Medicare patient is administered Fluzone High-Dose vaccine at a well visit.
