
Carper and Sen. Coons were present to kick off the event which centered the light on key issues affecting maternal health, including the "fourth trimester," which is defined as the first three months following birth. Gov. Carney and Lt. Gov. Bethany Hall-Long issued a proclamation making January 23, 2019 (1/23 or 1-2-3) Maternal Health Awareness Day. The day was designated in New Jersey in 2017 and is now observed in Delaware and Pennsylvania.

Officials Requesting Vigilance in Reporting Cases

The Division of Public Health (DPH) has issued a health advisory for physicians and health care professionals to be vigilant in

reporting cases of Haemophilus influenzae



(H. influenzae) serotype A. This alert comes after a child died in Sussex

County from the infection. DHP is asking parents to consult a physician if they notice symptoms such as pneumonia, pink eye, ear infections or sinus infections. Physicians are required to notify DPH with any confirmed cases. Read more.

Last month the Delaware Health Care Commission awarded several mini-grants as part of the State Innovation Model (SIM) initiative. The value-based payment reform mini-grants were awarded to Delaware health care providers to facilitate data integration, improve the coordination of patient care or increase readiness to integrate into an Accountable Care Organization (ACO) or operate through an Alternative Payment Method (APM). It was not surprising that many of the mini-grants were awarded to larger health care organizations and facilities, including MSD's MedNet. But, Stoney Batter Family Medicine, an ever-growing family practice, was awarded not one, but two mini-grants.

Stonev Batter Family Medicine

(\$73,000): To upgrade its Allscripts system to facilitate better data-sharing required for participation in value-based programs, conversion to electronic billing and training sessions for employees.

Stoney Batter Family Medicine
 (\$20,000): To design a training program
 for care coordinators/providers on how
 to prevent emergency department and
 hospital readmissions utilizing hospital based admission information from
 DHIN, its ACO practice dashboard for
 Medicare patients, and its EHR stem to
 optimize communication.
