Delaware Treatment and Referral Network

The Department of Health and Social Services' Division of Substance Abuse and Mental Health (DSAMH) last week launched its online referral network called the Delaware Treatment and Referral Network (DTRN) which allows Delaware health care professionals seeking substance use disorder treatment or mental health services for their patients to make a digital referral with one of 24 organizations participating in the first phase. The Delaware Treatment and Referral Network also supports the identification of peer recovery support services and pre-authorizations by the Eligibility and Enrollment Unit at DSAMH for certain substance use disorder referrals. Time to Renew your Respiratory Care License

A renewal notice will be sent to the email address on the record, this notice will explain how to access the online renewal application. To complete the online renewal application, you must use a credit card to pay your renewal fee. Respiratory Care Practitioner licenses expire on November 30 of even-numbered years (2018, 2020, etc.). Physician M.D., Physician D.O., Physician Assistant, Acupuncture Practitioner, and Genetic Counselor licenses expire on March 31 of odd-numbered years (2017, 2019, etc.). To renew, you must certify that you have completed the Mandatory Training in addition to the Continuing Medical Education (CME) required by the RCPAC Rules and Regulations. MIPS Targeted Review Request: Deadline October 15

If you participated in the Merit-based Incentive Payment System (MIPS) in 2017, your MIPS final score and performance feedback are available on the Quality Payment Program website. The payment adjustment you receive in 2019 is based on this final score. If you believe there is an error in your 2019 MIPS payment adjustment calculation, request a targeted review until October 15 at 8 pm ET. For more information visit: https://tinyurl.com/NovitasNews.

New Medicare Card: Replacement Card

If your patients accidentally threw away their new Medicare card, ask them to call 1-800-MEDICARE and request a replacement. Your patients can also sign into MyMedicare.gov to print an official card. They must create an account if they do not already have one.
