MIPS Reporting Deadline Less Than 1 Month Away

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) has officially opened the data submission period for Merit-based Incentive Payment System (MIPS) eligible clinicians who participated in Year 2 (2018) of the Quality Payment Program. Data can be submitted and updated any time until 8:00 pm ET on Tuesday, April 2, 2019. CMS Web Interface users need to report their Quality performance category data by 8:00 pm EST on March 22, 2019. Clinicians who reported Quality measures via Medicare Part B claims can sign in to qpp.cms.gov to view current performance based on claims that have been processed by your Medicare Administrative Contractor. Important Reimbursement Information - SB 227

Effective January 1, 2019, Delaware Senate Bill 227 requires individual, group, and State employee insurance plans to reimburse primary care physicians, certified nurse practitioners, physician assistants, and other front-line practitioners for chronic care management and primary care at no less than the physician Medicare rate for the next 3 years. It has come to MSD's attention that some insurance payers may not be meeting this mandate. Please note that this may not apply to some large group employer plans which are regulated by federal law.

Medical License Renewal Deadline Approaching

Medical licenses will expire on March 31 of odd-numbered years (2017, 2019, etc.). If you fail to renew by the expiration date, see Renewing an Expired License at http://tinyurl.com/DEMEDLIC. You must certify that you have completed the Mandatory Training in addition to the Continuing Medical Education (CME) required by the Rules and Regulations for your license. You may be selected for audit of your CME following the renewal. Note that, if you hold a controlled substance registration, you must file a separate renewal application. See Controlled Substances Registration Renewal http://tinyurl.com/DELCSR2019. If you have opted-in to the MSD CME Tracking Service, be sure to send in all awarded CME credits to update your record.
