DPH Issues Guidance to Increase Awareness of Brucellosis

The Division of Public Health (DPH) is issuing guidance to increase awareness among health care professionals about the risk of brucellosis associated with unpasteurized food sources after a third presumptive positive case in Sussex County since late May 2019. All three cases involve individuals who consumed homemade unpasteurized dairy products from Mexico. Health care professionals caring for febrile patients or patients who exhibit the symptoms (refer to DPH letter) -who come from, have visited, or have friends - or relatives who have visited a country where brucellosis is endemic, should consider brucellosis among their differential diagnoses. Is Your Clearinghouse Submitting Your Medicare Claims With The MBI?

If you send the Medicare Beneficiary Identifier (MBI) to your vendor/clearinghouse on your Medicare claim for payment, but you see both the Health Insurance Claim Number (HICN) and the MBI on your remittance advice, your vendor/clearinghouse is not using the MBI when submitting your claims. Starting January 1, 2020, Medicare will reject claims with the HICN, with a few exceptions. For more information visit https://tinyurl.com/MLN71819.
