### **DPH COVID-19 Vaccination Playbook**

The Delaware Division of Public Health (DPH) has released its COVID-19 Vaccination Playbook, which lays out how it expects to navigate the distribution of the COVID-10 vaccine. Due to an expected shortage of the vaccine, Delaware plans to make the two-shot series available in a multiple step approach by prioritizing population groups starting with persons serving in health care settings who have the potential for direct or indirect exposure to patients or infectious materials. # Tell Congress Now is Not The Time to Cut Medicare Payments

In just the last few weeks, bipartisan legislation has been introduced to address these concerns. The "Holding Providers Harmless from Medicare Cuts During COVID-19 Act" (H.R. 8207), would freeze payments at 2020 rates for services scheduled to be cut in 2021 for a period of two years, while allowing the scheduled office Evaluation and Management service increases to take place. Analyses of this approach show improved overall impact numbers for all physician specialties. ### Reminder: 2021 Controlled Substance Registration Renewal

Delaware physicians holding a Controlled Substance Registration (CSR) license, will be required to renew by June 30, 2021. All practitioners who apply for a Delaware controlled substance registration (CSR) must complete a mandatory two-hour, two part course pertaining to safe prescribing and distributing of controlled substances, treatment of pain, and recognizing and treating opioid use disorder. This two-part course is also the approved course for meeting the requirement for reviewing a practitioner's CSR. Note that this is the ONLY approved course for meeting the CSR renewal requirement. Practitioners initially issued a CSR for a period less than two years do NOT need to repeat this course in that initial licensure period. All other CSR holders must complete this course to meet the two-hour continuing education requirement each renewal cycle.
