Controlled Substance Registration Renewal Deadline June 30

All controlled substance registrations must be renewed on a biennial basis. The current deadline for renewal is June 30, 2021. As a condition of renewal, a registrant must complete the mandatory two-part continuing education course provided by the Delaware Division of Professional Regulation, relating to the safe prescribing and distribution of controlled substances, the treatment of chronic pain, and the recognition and treatment of opioid use disorder. Completion of the two-part course satisfies this requirement. CSR renewal must be completed through the Delpros system at https://delpros.delaware.gov/OH_HomePage. Moderna Announces Its Vaccine Is Highly Effective For Adolescents

Moderna's COVID-19 vaccine is reported to be 100% effective in children ages 12-17 in a clinical trial. In June, Moderna will seek Food and Drug Administration (FDA) emergency use approval to give the vaccine to teens. If approved, this would be the second COVID-19 vaccine available to US adolescents behind the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine, which federal regulators authorized for use for 12-15 year-olds. COVID-19 Variants Given Greek Alphabet Names By WHO

The World Health Organization (WHO) has unveiled new names for COVID-19 variants of concern, naming the variants after letters of the Greek alphabet instead of their place of first discovery and is encouraging national authorities, media outlets, and others to adopt the new labels. The four variants of concern, UK/Kent (B.1.1.7), South Africa (B.1.351), Brazil (P.1), and India (B.1.617.2), have been given the letters Alpha, Beta, Gamma, and Delta respectively to reflect their order of detection, but the renaming will not replace existing scientific names.
