Law Mandates Medical Certification of Death Electronically

Governor Carney signed Senate Bill 69 into law on March 30, 2021, mandating the medical certification of death electronically. Anyone who certifies death certificates must register to use the Delaware Vital Events Registration System (DeVERS), which is utilized to register all vital events.
