HHS Announces \$25.5 Billion in COVID-19 Provider Funding

Relief Funding Phase 4 payments will be based on lost revenues and expenditures between July 1, 2020, and March 31, 2021. To support providers with the most need, smaller-sized practices that tend to operate on thin margins and often serve vulnerable or isolated communities will be reimbursed for lost revenues and COVID-19 expenses at a higher rate compared to larger providers. Vaccination Requirements For Health Care Settings

The Biden-Harris Administration announced a 6-pronged national COVID-19 strategy (https://tinyurl.com/x3az4hs) that includes the requirement of COVID-19 vaccination of staff within all Medicare and Medicaid-certified facilities to protect both them and patients from the virus and its more contagious Delta variant. The President also announced a mandate ordering all businesses with more than 100 employees to require their workers to be immunized or face weekly testing. In addition, President Biden signed an executive order compelling all federal employees to get vaccinated without an option for regular testing. The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS), in collaboration with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), announced also that emergency regulations requiring vaccinations for nursing home workers will be expanded to include hospitals, dialysis facilities, ambulatory surgical settings, and home health agencies as a condition for participating in the Medicare and Medicaid programs. DelVAX Portal Provides Access To Vaccination Information

DelVAX is a confidential online computer system used statewide to track immunizations. The DelVAX portal (https://tinyurl.com/km72vs6p) can be a convenient place for those who need to provide proof of COVID-19 vaccination but have lost or misplaced their vaccination card. The Delaware Division of Public Health (DPH) does not replace a missing or misplaced vaccination card. According to DPH, any Delawareans who experience challenges accessing their immunization records through the DelVAX portal should complete a public portal data form. Consideration of COVID-19 Booster Doses

In a review published in *The Lancet*, experts, including some at the Food and Drug Administration and the World Health Organization, indicate any advantage of booster doses would not outweigh protecting those who remain unvaccinated worldwide. The authors indicated additional doses may be useful in some with weak immune systems and argue that the general population does not yet need them.
