# **COVID-19 Vaccine May Soon Been Available for 5-11 Year-Olds**

This week, Pfizer and BioNTech announced its vaccine was safe and effective for children ages 5 to 11 years old, and that it would seek U.S. approval for providing the vaccine to the younger age group. A lower dose was tested, equating to a third of the amount in the vaccine that is given now. The companies have indicated the lower dosage has proved safe, with similar or fewer temporary side effects that teens experience (sore arm, fever, achiness). The goal is to apply to the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) by the end of the month for emergency use authorization for this age group. The FDA has indicated that, once it receives the study results, the agency hopes to evaluate the data in a matter of weeks to determine if the vaccine is both safe and effective for this age group. Topline readouts for the other two age cohorts from the trial – children 2 to 5 years of age and children 6 months to 2 years of age – are expected by the fourth quarter this year. # **Pfizer Recalls All Lots of Chantix Nationwide**

The U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) has announced a voluntary Pfizer recall of **all lots** of Chantix 0.5 mg and 1 mg tablets due to the unacceptable levels of N-nitroso-varenicline, a type of nitrosamine. This follows Pfizer halting distribution this summer and then recalling more than a dozen lots of the medicine in August. Chantix supply disruptions led to a shortage. In July, the FDA allowed a global pharmaceutical company to import generics from Canada. The FDA last month approved a U.S. generic from Endo's Par Pharmaceutical. As alternative suppliers have been approved in the U.S., Pfizer is undertaking this precautionary measure. For more information visit https://tinyurl.com/4twiphsz.

#### **CDC Investment to Protect Patients and Health Care Workers**

The Biden-Harris Administration announced a \$2.1 billion investment to improve infection prevention and control activities across the U.S. public health and health care sectors. Working through the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the Administration is investing American Rescue Plan funding to strengthen and equip state, local, and territorial public health departments and other partner organizations with the resources needed to better fight infections in U.S. health care facilities, including COVID-19 and other known and emerging infectious diseases. Over the next three years, the CDC will issue \$1.25 billion of the total to 64 state, local, and territorial health departments to support this work.
