URGENT Physicians License Renewal Expired March 31

Delaware Physicians Licensure Renewal deadline was March 31. If you did not renew your license before the expiration date, your license has expired.

IT IS ILLEGAL TO PRACTICE IN DELWARE WHILE YOUR LICENCE IS EXPIRED.

A physician with an expired license, may file a late renewal application up to one year after the expiration date in DELPROS. **As a reminder it is illegal to practice in Delaware with an expired license.**

During your renewal process you are asked to attest that you have completed:

- The required CME
- Mandatory Training

You are also required to:

- Certify that you have not practice while your license has expired
- Pay a late fee, in addition to the renewal fee

If you fail to renew by the end of the one-year period, your license will terminate. To resume practicing in Delaware after termination, you must reapply in DELPROS at <https://delpros.delaware.gov/> as a new applicant.

Note: If you hold a controlled substance registration, you must file a separate renewal application, for more information on CSR renewal visit <https://dpr.delaware.gov/boards/controlledsubstances/renewal/>
The deadline to renew your CSR is June 30.
