The Delaware Division of Public Health (DPH) and the Delaware Emergency Management Agency (DEMA) announced that the State of Delaware is partnering with the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to open a free COVID-19 drive-thru testing site **from January 17 to February 7, 2022**. **Appointments will be required**. ## **Government Website for At-Home COVID Tests**

The Biden administration on Tuesday began taking orders for free rapid at-home COVID-19 tests, one day ahead of the planned launch of the website for ordering and distributing tests to people in the United States. The site launched officially mid-morning on Wednesday. The White House indicated the website's early launch is standard practice to troubleshoot. ## **DPH Laboratory Breaks Ground on Expansion**

The Delaware Public Health Laboratory (DPHL) will nearly double in size to increase the capacity for routine and outbreak testing to accommodate advanced technical laboratory staff and the infectious disease epidemiology program. State leaders held a groundbreaking for the expansion on the property of the Delaware Department of Health and Social Services' Hospital for the Chronically III, located on Sunnyside Road in Smyrna. The 40-person Infectious Disease Epidemiology Program will relocate from Dover. The facility will remain operational throughout the expansion process, and most work is anticipated to be completed by summer 2023. For more information https://tinyurl.com/58tzpdv3.

#### CDC Updates Mask Guidance Emphasizing Protection, Fit, Comfort

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) last week clarified its recommendation on various kinds of masks used for the prevention of transmission of SARS-CoV-2. The CDC indicated that cloth masks frequently worn by Americans do not offer as much protection as surgical masks or respirators. Well-fitting disposable surgical masks and KN95s are more protective than all cloth masks, and well-fitting respirators, including N95s, offer the highest level of protection. Wearing a highly protective mask or respirator may be most important for certain higher-risk situations, or by some people at increased risk for severe disease.
