

COVID-19 UPDATE 4-14-2020

In an effort to keep Delaware's medical community current on the latest information regarding the coronavirus crisis, the Medical Society of Delaware is sharing the following:

DPH Announces 165 New COVID-19 Cases and Two Additional Deaths

According to the Delaware Division of Public Health (DPH),165 new Delawareans have been diagnosed with COVID-19, taking the total number of lab-confirmed cases to 1,926, including 217 who are hospitalized, 45 of whom are critically ill.

Forty-three individuals have died due to COVID-19 in Delaware. The most recent deaths involved:

- 83-year-old female from Sussex County, long-term care facility
- 70-year-old female from Kent County, hospitalized
